

Inflatable, Hire Agreement

This agreement complies with the requirements laid down in the Health and Safety Executive Guidance "Safe use and operation of play inflatables, including bouncy castles" ES No.7 Health and Safety Executive Guidance "Safe use and operation of play inflatables".

This agreement also fulfils the requirements of our insurance company. The operating guidelines, hire agreement and disclaimer all form part of the hire agreement.

Ensure there is adequate First Aid equipment available before using the equipment and that two responsible adults supervise the inflatable to aid entry and exit and also supervise children at all times.

No eating, drinking, shoes, glasses, jewellery, buckles, key-rings, metal-studded clothing, pets, silly string, toys or other sharp instruments or similar items which could cause injury or damage allowed on inflatable at any time.

Do not inflate the inflatable on uneven ground or on areas where the surface contains foreign objects such as stones and debris that may damage the fabric.

The inflatable must not be used in wet and windy conditions and must also be suitably anchored at all times.

Do not relocate the inflatable.

Deflate the inflatable when not supervised or not in use. Keep children off the equipment when inflating/deflating to prevent risk of injury and to protect the inflatables structure.

Do not allow children to become too boisterous, push or collide with each other, be advised somersaults can be extremely dangerous with the possibility of serious back or neck injury.

Do not allow children to swing, climb or sit on the inflatable walls, as this can be very dangerous and possibly result in serious injury if they were to fall.

Do not allow anyone to bounce on the front safety step, a child could easily bounce off the inflatable and get hurt, the step is there to assist users on and off the inflatable.

No smoking fires or barbecues to be used near inflatable.

No one who is under the influence of alcohol may use this equipment

Ensure all electrical connections, extension leads, plugs and sockets, as well as the blower itself, are adequately protected from rain or water.

Consider medical conditions of the children using the equipment. Asthmatics and children with special needs may require additional supervision while using this equipment.

The inflatable must be returned in an acceptable condition, i.e. clean, unsoiled and undamaged. If not there will be an additional charge.

I understand and agree that:

A. Corfe Castles will not be held liable in any way for any injury or damage caused whilst using the inflatable equipment; however it may be caused, which may result in injury, death or any other loss or damage to me or anyone using the equipment while in my charge.

I personally accept all responsibility in connection with the inflatable equipment, for any harm, injury, loss or damage including all associated risk which may occur while I am hosting or controlling this event. I also accept responsibility for any damage occurring from or as a result of misuse or recklessness to the equipment and reimburse Corfe Castles for any loss incurred.

C. I further state that I am legally competent to sign this agreement, and that I understand the terms are contractual.

IT IS MY INTENTION WITH THIS SIGNATURE TO EXEMPT CORFE CASTLES FROM ALL LIABILITY WHATSOEVER FOR PERSONAL INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR WRONGFUL DEATH HOWEVER CAUSED WHILST USING THIS EQUIPMENT.

I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTOOD THIS AGREEMENT BEFORE SIGNING IT. I VERIFY THAT I UNDERSTAND THE NATURE OF THE ACTIVITIES INVOLVED, I WILL ENDEAVOUR TO ENSURE THAT ALL CHILDREN USING THIS EQUIPMENT ARE PHYSICALLY FIT, AND ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENT.
